Her method of working includes both conversation and artistic exercises, which help remove the layers of adaption covering the sense of who you really want to be. Details and Pricing

Training takes place at weekends, although if necessary it is possible to organize a two day slot during the week.

Cost of training

Individual **£180** a day / Institution **£260** a day / Unwaged **£140** a day.

The **two day course** is **10am - 4pm** on both days and includes lunch and tea and coffee breaks. Accommodation is not included and most clients stay locally in a bed and breakfast. Before the course Deborah will speak with you on the phone and give you one or two preparatory exercises to do. You will need to bring a large notebook, a pen and an open mind.
